RICK: Wants to build new hole between Holes 5/6 at Rainshadow. Easier hole, layout goes downhill from tee

Taylor: Knows PDGA sanctioning requirements for new holes

Rick: Met with Carter Droz on Feb. 14th, scheduler with PA city parks dept. Meet and greet between OPDGA and city parks, brought up random trees the city cut in Lincoln Park. Carter said the city would help with cutting down long grass near the dog park, someone will need to tell the city later in the year when the grass needs cutting. Rick wanted to emphasize we're not sneaking around to do course maintenance. Carter appreciated the course maintenance work being done.

Evan: Can provide letter from PA Disc Golf confirming of OPDGA involvement

Rick: Lincoln Park - Bryce Kalscheur nominated as course steward / maintenance lead. Voted and approved 5-0

Evan: Requested funds (approx. \$80 for gas) to hire Paul Goetz (the city's dog park volunteer) to use his Kabota to level out the Hole 13/14 mounds.

Rick: County parks budgeted ~\$4k for course maintenance. Rick requested money to be used for pagoda structure.

Taylor: Add Kenny as an approved vendor with county parks, so he can cater future course events. Charges about \$100 per day for course rental.

Rick: Wells Fargo balance \$2,688. Just deposited PA club \$\$ today (\$465) and \$189 from Rainshadow funds. Discussed whether PA/Lincoln Park money should be kept separate from Rainshadow money.

Evan: We may consider a meeting with PA club members to talk about the merging of funds. \$5k currently in the PA account. Evan has a basket in his garage, an extra from Lincoln Park, which is going to Rainshadow's new hole

EVAN: Emphasized all 24 holes at Lincoln Park have teepads, are playable. Need to get foot traffic on the new holes.
