 - Rick is now a member of the parks public advisory board
 - RS Pitch and putt
 - Jason spending most days clearing/weedwhacking
 - Lincoln Park plan 2026
 - Jeffrey / Rick did a walkthrough with Tim/Carter with City parks. City wants a proposal / map of our plans for Lincoln Park
 - New course map needs walking paths defined on it
 - Jeffrey provided course stats (one of the few 27-hole courses in the state).
 - Needs signage
 - No trash bags / garbage collection in forest holes
 - No one to empty them regularly
 - For major trash collection / encampments, contact 4PA (Bryce)
 - Concrete tee pads
 - Don't pile wood debris along fairways, neighbors get concerned. Disperse it into the woods instead
 - Build new Drop Zone near far-right mando on Hole 15 to meet new PDGA rules?
