PDGA league fees (~\$220) applied to Tags expenses

Baskets - Lincoln Park 3 basket (ran over by a truck doing donuts in fairway) chains repurposed to replace missing two Letter hole chains.

Need to order 10 new baskets (~\$500 each), plus a couple extra (one yellow, one red). Paint baskets white originally, powder coat to color later if necessary . Need sleeves as well.

Fundraiser for RS Short Course tee pads (concrete): Raindoubles in September?

Basket lock maintenance: Locks are very difficult to unlock. Need WD-40 and tools to unlock (Jason).

Tee Signs at Lincoln Park: Taylor showed off design / hole names. Once finalized, order signs sized for

the posts. Make the signs with an epoxy cover? Four 4x4 post diamond design.

50+ Soroptimist Fundraiser Event (Melanie S - Todd Coward's wife): Local Soroptimist Group proposing a 'Never Too Late To Learn' disc golf event for 50+ people at Lincoln Park. Saturday morning session with local Pros doing a clinic? Goals is to bring players, specifically older players and women. Proposal will be made to the Soroptimist's club in November for a grant request (\$5-6k, used for any professional pro to teach, snacks/drinks, course fees, insurance)

RS Putting Course: Need gravel from county (Jason) to make a hard-packed path, hopefully make it handicapped accessible.

Food Band Fundraiser - 2nd annual, two-day event for both PA and Sequim. November, Black Friday. Halloween doubles: Run by Bryce and Jesse again

Whitefeather - First Sat. of October. Taylor running it again, Paul Arndt assistant TD. Boobadoo's Kitchen and Cleaning sponsors, Iron Horse Band sponsor/performer, player's pack, metal trophies.

Camping at Rainshadow (Rick): Park Advisory Board meeting last Tuesday, 10-year plan. Biker / Hiker campsite. Don Crawford says no restriction on camping at course. Course would still be dry, no water/bathrooms. OPDGA board would not be expected to administer/maintain the camp sites

City of PA contract (Taylor): Jerry to follow up on PA insurance requirements. Goal is for the city to provide lawn mowing services. OPDG, coordinates course maintenance/upkeep, and rely on OPDGA insurance for course coverage (only for OPDGA events/tournaments).
